Hospital Requested Enhancement	Keyboard navigation enhancements <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tabbing order has been adjusted on the Infection Control Screen and Patient Presentation pages to make frequently used features quicker to access. The tab order of action buttons at the bottom of each page has been reversed (right to left) so the most frequently used button is accessed first. Pressing Enter on any triage note tab opens that tab for documenting notes. Keyboard shortcuts have been added for accessing the triage note tabs as well as the 'New Patient', 'Print' and 'I'm Done Triage' buttons. The Enter and Esc keys can be used in place of the 'I'm Done' and 'Clear' buttons when documenting vital signs. 	✓	✓		
	Watermark added to draft print reports <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Printing a triage report from any queue will have a 'Draft' watermark applied if a triage assessment was not fully documented for the patient. 	✓	✓		
	Print report no longer assumes patient pretriage is completed by an RN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person completing the pretriage for a patient no longer shows on the print report as 'Pretriage RN'. This label has been changed to 'Pretriage by' to reflect the wider range of staff completing this portion of the documentation. 	✓	✓

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When documenting subjective notes for a CEDIS complaint of 'Pregnancy > 20 wks', the pop-up panel for recommended assessment reminders has been updated to include a more comprehensive assessment. The recommended assessment reminder for the CEDIS complaint 'Pregnancy < 20 wks' has also been modified slightly. 				
	<p>Triage location confirmation on login</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When logging into the eCTAS Clinical Application, all nurses will see a pop-up with the name and logo of the hospital site they are accessing while the application loads in the background. The pop-up will close automatically after a few seconds. If the name or logo does not match the nurse's current work location, they should log out to avoid a potential privacy breach when patient information is sent to the wrong facility. 	✓	✓		
	<p>Infection Control Screen</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Global travel alerts are now shown separately from country-specific alerts. When PHO designates one or more alerts as global, a new indicator is shown next to each of the two travel questions  Global travel alert (3). The indicator shows how many global alerts are currently active. The alert text can be viewed by hovering over the indicator. Country-specific alerts are indicated by the country name appearing in red text in the country list. The alert text can be viewed by hovering over the country name once it has been selected. 	✓	✓		
	<p>Nurse Notifications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The design of notification messages for release notices and What's New videos has been updated to better reflect the content of these notification messages. A new icon  has been added to signify a notification is a release notice or What's New video. 	✓	✓		

	<p>Direct Link to What's New in eCTAS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A new icon  has been added in the eCTAS Clinical Application header next to the Online Help icon. Clicking this icon opens the 'Release Notes and What's New Videos' online help page in a new tab. A similar icon has been added in the Administration Console. 				
	<p>Administration Console</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A tool that allows Ontario Health administrators to manage nurse notifications has been enhanced. This tool is not visible to hospital users. A tool that allows Ontario Health administrators to manage country precautions has been enhanced. This tool is not visible to hospital users. Instead of being assigned to all countries, global alerts are now included in a dedicated section in the response.
