User Interface (UI) Changes	<ul> <li>EULA acceptance screen</li> <li>The End User License Agreement (EULA) acceptance screen in both the eCTAS Clinical and Administration applications has been updated to provide the name of the eCTAS Facility Role Administrator (previously known as eCTAS Roles Coordinator or eRC) for the new user. After accepting the EULA, new nurses and administrative users should contact their eCTAS Facility Role Administrator to be assigned access to eCTAS.</li> </ul>				
HL7 Message Processing	<ul> <li>Missing PV2 segment</li> <li>Incoming ADT A04, A05 and A08 messages that previously failed to process when the PV2 segment was missing will now be processed. The PV2 segment for these message types is used to indicate patient mode of arrival which is <u>not</u> a required field.</li> </ul>		•		
	<ul> <li>Invalid gender code</li> <li>The message error code has been corrected for incoming Registration messages that contain an invalid gender code. Error code 20210 (Patient Gender can only have one of the following values: Male, Female, Unknown) is now returned instead of error code 99999 (Unhandled Exception)</li> </ul>		<b>I</b>

	<ul> <li>Missing ED visit number</li> <li>A workflow issue that occasionally prevented the processing of Registration messages that specified an eCTAS episode ID (PV1-50) but not an ED Visit Number (PV1-19) has been corrected.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Duplicate Registration messages</li> <li>A workflow issue that allowed some duplicate Registration messages to show a successful processing status has been corrected. Only one Registration message is accepted per episode and the correct error code will now be returned for any duplicate messages.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Outbound Triage message not sent to HIS</li> <li>A workflow issue that resulted in rare failures when constructing outbound triage messages has been corrected.</li> </ul>				
Bug Fixes	<ul> <li>Triage Notes</li> <li>A workflow issue that resulted in triage data failing to save in eCTAS due to an invalid triage note has been corrected.</li> <li>A user interface limitation that past triage notes copied from both previous visit and triage note history and then removed from the triage could not be added back to the triage has been corrected.</li> </ul>	<b>⊘</b>			
	<ul> <li>Clinical Application Error Pages</li> <li>An error that prevented the eCTAS Supported Browsers page from loading correctly in Firefox has been corrected.</li> <li>A workflow issue that allowed users to be redirected to an invalid link instead of the eCTAS Supported Browsers page has been corrected.</li> <li>An error in the eCTAS Sign-in link on the Page Not Found error page has been corrected.</li> </ul>
