- Navigate to **Settings > More Tools > Clear Browsing Data**
OR click and hold **Ctrl + Shift + Delete** on your keyboard
- Select the Time Range All time
- Click the Advanced tab in the dialog box that appears
- Ensure only Cached images and files, and Hosted app data are checked
- Click Clear Data
- Close and reopen your browser window, and login to eCTAS

Ministry Requested Enhancement	<p>Syndromic Surveillance for Suspected COVID patients</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Ministry of Health has requested that all Triage Nurses indicate whether a patient received at Triage is suspected to have COVID-19 based on travel, contacts or symptoms. Providing this information will allow the Ministry of Health to support syndromic surveillance and decision making for the province. Nurses are required to use the specific key word 'Suspected COVID' in the subjective notes when appropriate. This release will add the red text below as a reminder to all front line nurses.
