Hospital Requested Enhancement	<b>Potential duplicate triage warning</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A new pop-up notification has been added to the Pretriaged Patients queue to alert nurses when they start a triage for a patient marked as 'Triage in Progress' by another nurse. The nurse can cancel the popup to return to the queue or choose to continue to triage the patient if needed.</li> </ul>				
	<b>Site Level Extract enhancements</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Three new fields related to infection control screening have been added to the Site Level Extract: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Screening Status</b> indicates 'Unable to Screen' if the nurse marked the 'Unable to complete screening due to patient condition' checkbox on the Infection Control Screening (ICS) page. This same field indicates 'Screened' if any of the ICS questions are answered by the nurse</li> <li><b>Selected Precaution</b> provides the precaution measure selected by the nurse on the ICS screen, if any</li> <li><b>Suspected COVID-19</b> indicates 'TRUE' if the nurse entered 'Suspected COVID' in the Subjective Notes and 'FALSE' otherwise. This field is populated for all hospitals, not just those that complete infection screening in eCTAS.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>				
User Interface (UI) Changes	<b>Vital Sign and Modifier Information Icons</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A new information icon  has been added to select vital signs and modifiers. Nurses can hover over the information icon to view additional details about the vital sign or modifier. The reference material provided is for</li> </ul>				

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	<p><b>Unsaved episodes sent to eCTAS on logout</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To ensure all completed triages are transferred to eCTAS and the HIS (for Complex hospitals), any triage records in the process of saving are automatically submitted when the nurse logs out. Records are considered in the process of saving while the 'Saving Assessment' and 'Click to Cancel' messages are shown in the Triage Patients queue.</li> </ul>				
Bug Fixes	<p><b>Interruptions while entering TOA and Reassessment notes</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An issue that caused text entry fields such as TOA and Reassessment notes to stop accepting text when the patient queue was refreshed has been corrected. Nurses will no longer need to click back into the fields to resume typing after the queue refreshes.</li> </ul>				
	<p><b>Calculated CTAS score replaced by override score in Site Level Extracts</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A workflow that resulted in CTAS override scores appearing in the calculated CTAS score column in the Site Level Extracts has been corrected.</li> </ul>				
	<p><b>Timestamps incorrect on user role assignment</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An issue in the Site Role Management tool which caused an incorrect timestamp to be logged when a user was assigned a role has been corrected. There is no visible change for eCTAS Roles Coordinators.</li> </ul>				
Performance Improvements	<p><b>Queue refresh optimization</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The queue refresh button has been optimized to prevent cases where data already received in eCTAS is resubmitted.</li> </ul>				
	<p>General security upgrades and instrumentation enhancements have been made to ensure system stability and security.</p>
